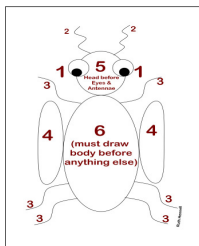

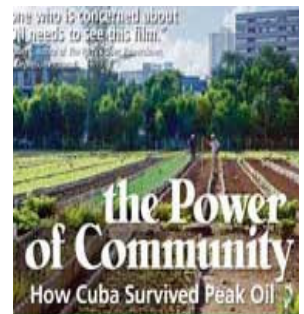

followed by discussion of how we will cope with Peak Oil.

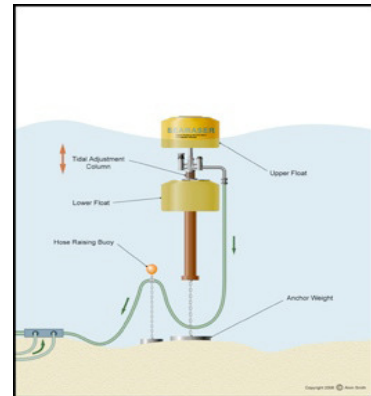
